Subject: FW: SEDAR Steering Committee August 2006 Draft Minutes

Attached are the summary minutes of the SEDAR Steering Committee. This committee labeled the Red Drum benchmark as tentative (See Attachment 1 to the summary minutes). That action is discussed on page 4 , 2nd paragraph of the minutes. The concern was whether there was adequate data and progress on research needs for Gulf red drum. The Steering Committee recommended that the council's SSC review red drum data and recommend whether benchmark assessments are appropriate. The Gulf Council's representatives on the Steering Committee agreed to coordinate with the Gulf States and GSMFC to evaluate red drum data availability.

The Council's Administrative Policy Committee in the course of developing the SOPPS SSC operations section considered whether to (1) include the provision that the SSC review the red drum data and recommend whether benchmark assessments are appropriate and (2) coordinate with the fishery commission in this task. Instead the Administrative Policy Committee and Council by substitute motion moved to defer this issue to the appropriate Committee (i.e., Red Drum Management Committee)
