As you know the MSRA includes language authorizing the establishment of a Council Coordination Committee (CCC) consisting of the chairs, vice chairs, and executive directors of each of the 8 Councils, or other Council members or staff, in order to discuss issues of relevance to all Councils, including issues related to the implementation of the MSRA. The MSRA may be read to require Council action to establish the CCC, rather than to automatically establish the CCC .

With the meeting in May approaching, this would seem like a good time to formally establish the CCC. To that end, we recommend that each Council pass the motion below. Such a motion would best ensure that there are no concerns about the May CCC meeting.

Uniform Council Motion to Establish Council Coordination Committee

There shall be established a Council Coordination Committee consisting of the Chairs, Vice Chairs, and Executive Directors of each of the eight regional fishery management councils, other council members, and staff. The Chairs, Vice Chairs, and Executive Directors shall be voting members. The six NOAA Fisheries Regional Administrators or their designees, other council members, and staff shall be non-voting members. The Council Coordinating Committee shall meet from time to time as appropriate to discuss issues of relevance to all councils. The Council Coordinating Committee may establish such subcommittees as it deems appropriate.
