

Judy Lang is the Scientific Coordinator of the Atlantic and Gulf Rapid Reef Assessment Project ([ww.agrra.org](http://www.agrra.org)), and the Chief Curator of the revised *Our Reefs: Caribbean Connections* traveling exhibit (www.ourreefs.org). Formerly she was a curator at the Texas Memorial Museum and a lecturer in diverse science departments at the University of Texas at Austin. She received a B.Sc. (London) in Chemistry and Zoology from the University College of the West Indies, and a M.S. and Ph.D. (Biology) from Yale University.

She is a Caribbean-area reef scientist with experience of stony coral behavior, ecology, biogeochemistry, taxonomy, bleaching and monitoring, as well as Native American knowledge systems, exhibit design and public outreach education.
